

Who are Native Americans?

- Descendants of the first people to live in North America
- Separated into various tribes (Cherokee, Navajo, Timucua, etc.)
- Thousands murdered during American colonization
- American land was taken from them
- Currently live on reservations today



Reservations Today AKA "The Rez"

- Separate government from the U.S.
- Tribal government
- Still located in the U.S.
- Largely poor/underfunded
- Polluted
- Celebration of traditional culture




Plot Elements Review: Setting

- Where and when a story takes place
- EX) for "Finding Nemo": Under the sea, Australia, modern day



Plot Elements Review: Plot



- The order of events in a story that makes up the beginning, middle, and end.
- Revolves around a **conflict** or problem.
 - EX) Scar wants to take the kingdom from Mufasa and Simba.


Plot Elements Review: Characters

- The people in the novel.
- Their words, thoughts, and actions move the events in the story forward.



Plot Elements Review: Theme vs. Topic

- **Theme** = an important message about life/life lesson the author wants the reader to know.
- **Topic** = what the story is LITERALLY about
 - EX) Lion King
 - Topic = two lions battle for kingship of the animal kingdom
 - Theme = dishonestly, disloyalty, and jealously will never overshadow honesty, kindness, and loyalty




